ABOUT THE WEB CLASS

Assistive Technology (AT) is technology used to improve functional capabilities of students with disabilities. This course teaches a collaborative team model for assessing an individual student's need for AT. Topics include the use of Education Tech Points, the SETT Framework, Framing the Question, Environmental Assessment, and Evaluation of Effectiveness. The focus is on team-based assessment for children with disabilities in school programs. However, the content regarding assistive technology assessment is applicable to all ages.

The class will run for 10 weeks during the winter term from January 9 through March 16, 2012. Students wishing to enroll in the class must have access to a computer with internet capabilities. All class materials will be sent electronically to students. Participants will be given a screen name and password which will allow them access to class materials and discussion groups. Weekly assignments and discussions will take place on an interactive web site. There is no class meeting time. Participants may sign on and enter discussion threads at any time each week.

Please note: This class is a revision of a previous course entitled "Models of Assistive Technology Assessment" previously offered for two hours of quarter credit.

ABOUT THE PRESENTER

Gayl Bowser is an independent consultant and the former coordinator of the Oregon Technology Access Program. She has been an assistive technology specialist for over 30 years and is nationally known for her work in assistive technology. Ms Bowser is co-author with Penny Reed of *Education Tech Points*, which is the primary source of materials for the class.
