
J oin us for an interactive internet class about assistive technology implementation. After an IEP team completes an assistive technology assessment and and chooses assistive technology tools for a child with disabilities, the work has only begun. Implementation planning, inclusion strategies and evaluation of the effectiveness of the assistive technology program are essential if AT is to become a useful tool for an assistive technology user. This course introduces the following ideas:

- **1. Re-SETTing after the assessment is complete**
- 2. Aspects of assistive technology competence
- 3. Creating an environment for AT success
- 4. Evaluating effectiveness of the plan

The class will run for the spring term from April 1 through June 6, 2004. Students wishing to enroll in the class must have access to a computer with internet capabilities. Weekly assignments and discussions will take place on an interactive web site. Assignments can be completed at any time. Students who enroll in the class will be given a screen name and password for access to class discussion groups. Print materials, including the manuals *Education Tech Points: A Framework for Assistive Technology Planning* and *How do you know it? How can you show it?* will be mailed to all students.
